Descripción del proyecto: This project aims to critically analyse the representation of queer identities in recent Latin American fiction films (2013-2018), emphasising from a phenomenological approach how touch, embodiment, and affection not only elicit a more engaging and progressive portrayal of queer ways of being but also allow to (re)consider the dynamic of political alignment/adaptation in societies across Latin America regarding the global LGTBQI+ agenda, especially in aspects such as social visualisation and ethical inclusiveness.
